**(Mark 5: 21-43)**

Being put on \_\_\_\_\_ is a familiar as well as \_\_\_\_\_  
experience for many of us.

It’s particularly frustrating when the matter you’re calling about is  
\_\_\_\_\_.

Have you ever wondered... “Why does the Master seem to  
\_\_\_\_\_ sometimes?”

3 things:

**#1. – This question goes right to the heart of \_\_\_\_\_.**

**#2. – When we are put on hold, as we sometimes are, we hold on
