**( Acts 26: 12-23)**

The book by Henry Drummond, “**The Changed Life**,” implies that all people are living by some \_\_\_\_\_.

All of us have some \_\_\_\_\_ in life.

The word “**vision**” is found how many times in the Bible? \_\_\_\_\_

Visions are usually what one scholar calls “a \_\_\_\_\_ manifestation...that serves a divine revelation of something otherwise secret.”

What happened to Paul after a Christian named Ananias laid hands on Paul and prayed for him? \_\_\_\_\_

King Agrippa’s vision was one where “might was \_\_\_\_\_,” where \_\_\_\_\_ had its privileges.

We could divide the vision into two parts: A vision for our \_\_\_\_\_ lives, and a vision for the \_\_\_\_\_.

**1. The Vision for the individual Christian in the years ahead is going to Involve more Personal \_\_\_\_\_.**

*[2 Peter 3:18 – “Grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.”]*
