## June 3, 2018 <u>"Treasure Hidden In A Clay Jar"</u> (2 Corinthians 4:5-12)

Everybody loves a good story of a successful \_\_\_\_\_ hunt.

People don't recognize that our treasure is the most \_\_\_\_\_\_ of all because it is hidden in an innocuous and \_\_\_\_\_\_ clay jar.

What is this treasure Paul is describing? It is "the light of the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God's glory displayed in the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of Christ."

Jesus called it the \_\_\_\_\_ of great price.

And where does that light shine? It shines "in our ."

Let's break down this lesson and make it practical for our lives....

## #1. – We need to note that the treasure about which Paul speaks does not lie somewhere "\_\_\_\_\_."

Many of us are obsessed with finding \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ outside of ourselves.

As someone said, \_\_\_\_\_\_ is an inside job.

Wealth and fame will satisfy some of your craving, but they will not give you a feeling of contentment and \_\_\_\_\_\_.

## #2. – If we have the treasure within that Paul speaks of, we can \_\_\_\_\_\_ whatever comes to us from \_\_\_\_\_\_.

Life can be cruel to us, but if we have this treasure, \_\_\_\_\_\_ cannot conquer us.

If we do not have sufficient \_\_\_\_\_\_ within at such a time of adversity, we are \_\_\_\_\_.

#3. – We need to understand that this treasure is not to be found by \_\_\_\_\_\_ "in" so much as it is in looking "\_\_\_\_\_."

The path to inner \_\_\_\_\_\_ is not simply a matter of getting in touch with our \_\_\_\_\_\_ but getting in touch with our \_\_\_\_\_\_

True happiness is not a matter of "good \_\_\_\_\_" but soul searching \_\_\_\_\_!

We recognize that to have this treasure we look not \_\_\_\_\_\_ or outwardly.

We look to God, a Father who is always with us regardless of our circumstances or our \_\_\_\_\_!

## 2 Corinthians 4:7 –

"We have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this allsurpassing power is from God and not from us."
