## March 22, 2020 <u>"You Have A Story To Tell!"</u> (John 9:1-41)

We really hold tight to this idea of being a \_\_\_\_\_ - \_\_\_\_ man or woman.

This issue of earning our \_\_\_\_\_, deserving our blessings, has been around a long time.

Whether we win or lose, we don't \_\_\_\_\_\_ either state!
