**“When Someone Disagrees With You”**  
**(Matthew 18:15-20)**

All of us have encountered someone with whom it is \_\_\_\_\_  
to get along.

Anywhere there are human beings there are \_\_\_\_\_,  
conflicts, \_\_\_\_\_, maybe all out wars.

\_\_\_\_\_ has been the rule not the exception for most of human  
history.

Someone put it this way...

*To dwell above with saints we love, oh that will be glory. But to dwell  
below with saints we know, well, that's another story!"*

Today's lesson from Matthew's Gospel deals with disagreeable people  
in the \_\_\_\_\_.

If we start casting out people because of their \_\_\_\_\_, we're going

The answer is not \_\_\_\_\_. The answer is to build a church  
that is so loving, so committed, that people \_\_\_\_\_ in their

Why did this teaching occupy so much of Christ's teachings?

**#2. – Because the church at its best deals not with people's

And often for each other flows, the sympathizing tear...”*
